### **BoldFuture for the Coastal Bend Wants Your Thoughts – in 15 Minutes or Less** *Organizers providing fast and easy sessions to get community input Nov. 15 and 17*

You've heard of speed dating. Now you can try "speed visioning" with BoldFuture for the Coastal Bend!

In just 15 minutes, participants can share their vision for the future of the Coastal Bend as well as what they value about it, their thoughts on the issues facing the region and a concrete step to attain their vision.

Results will be used to develop a long-term vision and action plan to guide the region into the future. BoldFuture for the Coastal Bend is seeking input from residents throughout Nueces and San Patricio Counties.

Two opportunities for "Speed Visioning" are scheduled—10 a.m. to 2 p.m. on Saturday, Nov. 15, and 4:30 to 6 p.m. on Monday, Nov. 17. Organizers will hold both events in Computer Lab 123 in Del Mar College's Center for Economic Development, located at 3209 S. Staples across from W. B. Ray High School.

Residents of all ages can stop by the Center and quickly complete the four vision questions on the BoldFuture survey either on a computer or on paper. Additionally, if participants want to hear a brief overview of the BoldFuture project or ask questions before completing the survey, they can stop in Room 126.

"All of us have a stake in the future of our city and region; we share dreams and concerns, and we need to let others hear our voice," says Joe Adame, community co-chair for BoldFuture. "I urge residents of all ages and backgrounds to participate in the Speed Visioning sessions on Saturday and Monday. It will take only a few minutes, but the effects will be long-lasting."

BoldFuture for the Coastal Bend is a grassroots community visioning initiative with leadership from Del Mar College and Texas A&M University-Corpus Christi and support from the City of Corpus Christi, Nueces County and the San Patricio County Economic Development Corporation.
